Event scheduled to start at 6 pm. It would be great if everyone could arrive no later than 6:15. If they do, they may miss out on some "Fan Favorite" votes. We have a maximum of 30 slots for cars and I'm ordering food for your club members to feed 60 people.

The location is on Lake Boulevard from Broad Street south to accommodate 30cars. Since north of Broad Street will be closed on Lake Blvd for other activities, we'll have you come in from the South. From M-63 take Park St. heading west to the lake which dead ends into Lake Blvd. Head north on Lake Blvd and we'll have the road blocked for the Car Event with Gladiator signs to indicate your entrance.

We will have food available starting at 6:30 pm (sandwiches, chips, fruit, dessert, water, soft drinks). They will be able to come up and help themselves. As they enter the area, we will give them a ticket to present for food so we ensure only your club members get the food.
